Dyber, highly polished 1 mm holes drilled through the stone terminating with "Dyber optic dish ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ " cuts, modified triangular shaped outline with beveled top, overall dimensions of the stone are $23.0 \times 20.5 \times 8.3 \mathrm{~mm}$, actual weight is 21.25 ct ., The stone is set with 3 " V " prongs in the 14 K yellow gold setting, designed and built by John A.
